ACHIEVEMENT STANDARD

By the end of Year 6, students explain the action of the Holy Spirit in the lives of believers. They analyse information from a variety of texts, including New Testament texts and the wisdom of Australian Catholic Christians. They demonstrate an understanding of the term 'communion of saints'. Students explain how Scriptural texts describe Jesus' relationship with God the Father and with humanity by selecting and using evidence from Sciptural texts to include the proclamation of Jesus as fulfilling God's promises in the Old Testament. Students identify and describe many ways in which faith is lived out in the lives of believers past and present, incldunig Catholics in a developing Australian nation (c. 1900 CE to present). They analyse the key messages and contexts of some Old Tetament prophets. They explain the significance of Jesus' New Law for the way believers live their faith and examine the spiritual and corporal works of mercy. Students identify and escribe many ways in which faith is celebrated in the lives of believers, past and present, including the commemoration of High Holy Days by Jewish believers; the Church's liturgical year and the celebration of Eucharist. They explain the significance of personal and communal prayer including the Our Father and the Examen and the use of meditative prayer practices especially prayer journaling for the spiritual life of believers. They participate respectfully in a variety of personal and communal prayer experiences including spiritual exercises and meditative prayer practices.
